



Rainbow Pre-School Demographic Report 2018-2019



Ely is England's second smallest City with a population of about 18,000. It is famous for its magnificent Norman Cathedral known locally as 'The Ship of the Fens'. Ely is an important tourist destination for day trips, and has a range of other attractions including its riverside walks, the award winning Jubilee Gardens, Ely Country Park and Ely Museum.

The City has grown rapidly in recent years with a significant amount of new housing and future plans for more sites for development and infrastructure provision.

The local population has a Gypsy/Roma/Traveller heritage and high numbers of more recently arrived Polish, Lithuanian and East European speakers.

Rainbow is a small Pre School in Ely for children aged 2 years 6 months to 4 years. We run three afternoon sessions for 3-4yr olds exclusively. All other sessions are for mixed ages with some children staying for the morning or afternoon, and some children staying all day (9.15am till 2.45pm). The setting is registered for 55 children and currently has 36 on roll, with more children due to start after Christmas. Each session has a maximum of 20 children.

We currently have a total of 36 children in the setting, consisting of 16 (44%) boys and 20 (56%) girls.

The setting's intake is predominantly White British but in recent years there has been a small increase in children from other groups. We have 5 (14%) children who speak English as an additional language.

We have 0 (0%) children with SEN.

We have 13 (36.11%) children Autumn born, 18 (50%) children Spring born and 5 (13.88%) children Summer born.
